

- I. The church was crowded – why? vs. 1-2.
 - A. The Saviour was there, vs. 1.
 1. ...it was noised that he was in the house.
 2. Luke 8:37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again.
 - B. The scripture was there, vs. 2.
 1. ...he preached the word unto them, vs. 2.
- II. The church was concerned, vs. 3-4.
 - A. A sick mans' problem, vs. 3.
 1. ...they came unto him, bringing one sick of the palsy...
 - a. Acts 8:30-31 And Philip ran thither to him, and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest?
 - b. Acts 16:29-30 Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas,
 - c. Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
 - B. A saved man's solution, vs. 4.
 1. ...they uncovered the roof...let down the bed...
- III. A church that was changed, vs. 6-12.
 - A. The liberals were there, vs. 6.
 1. ...and reasoning in their hearts...
 - B. The Lord was there, vs. 11-12a.

2. ...We never saw it on this fashion. vs. 12.
