

The Greatest Doctrine – Salvation Matthew 1:21

- I. It is what Christ was born for, vs. 21.
 - A. The birth, vs. 21.
 1. ...thou shalt call his name JESUS... vs. 21.
 2. ...there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. Acts 4:12.
 - B. The burden, vs. 21.
 1. ...he shall save his people from their sins, vs. 21.
- II. It is what He died for, I John 4:8-10.
 - A. What God said, vs. 10.
 1. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us... vs. 10.
 2. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; Ephesians 5:25.
 - B. Who He sent, vs. 10.
 1. ...and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins, vs. 10.
 2. ...that we might live through him. vs. 9.
- III. It is what He lives for, John 14:1-3.
 - A. He shows us a place, vs. 1-2.
 1. Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. vs. 1-2.
 2. And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. 2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down

from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God [is] with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, [and be] their God. 4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. 5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. 6 And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. 7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. Revelation 21:1-7.

- B. He shows us a promise, vs. 3.
 1. ...I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also, vs. 3.
