

Who Is Fit to Teach

Daniel 1:8; 2:28-30; 3:16-18

I. Three important areas of conduct in order to be a teacher.

A. A life of purity, Daniel 1:8.

1. But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself... vs. 8.

B. A life of faith, 2:28; 3:16-18.

1. But there is a God in heaven... vs. 28 and he will deliver us out of thine hand... vs. 17.

2. Without faith it is impossible to please God. Hebrews 11:6.

3. For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him. II Chronicles 16:9.

4. Ye have not because you ask not – My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge... Hosea 4:6.

5. Isaiah 59:1-2 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.

6. ...ask, and ye shall receive... John 16:24.

7. ...open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. Revelation 3:20.

8. ...If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed... Matthew 17:20.

C. A life of humility, 2:28-30.

1. But there is a God in heaven... vs. 28.
