- I. God’s command to the woman, vs. 8-9.
  - A. (man looking up to God) Elijah’s word from God, vs. 8.
    1. And the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, vs. 8.
    2. (man looking at God and another man “?”)
    3. (money – God)
  - B. A widow prepared by God, vs. 9.
    1. (a poor widow) ...I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee, vs. 9.
    2. (someone looking surprised)
- II. God’s care for the woman, vs. 10-16.
  - A. Elijah’s request, vs. 10-12.
    1. ...Bring me...a morsel of bread in thine hand., vs. 11.
    2. (a poor, old, dirty woman on a curb)
    3. ...I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse...for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die., vs. 12.
    4. ...make me thereof a little cake first...and after make for thee and for thy son., vs. 13.
    5. (the old woman praying with the milk and bread) ...sustain thee., vs. 9.
  - B. The widow’s reward, vs. 15-16.
    1. ...she went and did... vs. 15. And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail... vs. 16.
