I. Their division, vs. 31-33.

A. The position of the Lord, vs. 31.

1. (Jesus on His throne) ...then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: vs. 31.
2. Joel 3:2 I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat...
3. Joel 3:12 2 Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about.
4. (Jesus on His throne)

B. The position of the living, vs. 33-34, 40.

1. And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father... vs. 33-34. ...my brethren... vs. 40.
2. (picture of sheep, goats, Jews "Brethren" and Christ)
3. (ARE NOT!)

II. Their deeds, vs. 35-45.

A. The deeds of the righteous, vs. 35-40.

1. ...ye have done it unto me., vs. 40.
2. (Hungry – Thirsty – Stranger – Naked – Sick – Prison)
3. ...I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me., vs. 35-36.

4. I John 3:17 But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him?

B. The deeds of the unrighteous, vs. 41-46.

1. ...ye did it not to me., vs. 45.
2. ...I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me no drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not., vs. 42-43.
3. Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink? When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee? Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me., vs. 37-40.
4. Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me., vs. 44-45.
5. ...unto me., vs. 40
6. ...not to me., vs. 45.
